We, the undersigned junior exhibitor and parent/guardian, certify that we own the steer described above (the "Steer") and have read, acknowledge, accept and will abide by all of the guidelines of the Noble Research Institute Junior Beef Excellence Program.

We further certify that to the best of our knowledge, the Steer, while under our ownership, possession or direct control:

- Has at all times been handled properly and humanely;
- If administered antibiotics, such antibiotics were administered under the auspices of a veterinarian and in compliance with FDA regulations and were not used solely for the purpose of growth promotion; and
- Was not adulterated within the meaning of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act, (i.e., the Steer has not been fed any feed containing ruminant derived meat and bone meal as set forth in 21 CFR 589.2000), and we agree to allow packer inspections of our feed ingredient records and facilities; and
- Has not been fed zilpaterol hydrochloride (Zilmax, Showmaxx, etc.).

We acknowledge and accept the fact that all animals entered in the program are subject to blood, urine and tissue tests and that the Noble Research Institute reserves the right to disqualify any animal, live or slaughtered, found in violation of the use of drugs, chemicals or feed additives as described above. If the Steer is disqualified because of a positive test and/or the carcass is condemned at slaughter, any financial responsibility resulting from said condemnation will be borne by the junior exhibitor and/or the junior exhibitor's parent/guardian.



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We will indemnify and hold harmless the Noble Research Institute, its present and former officers, directors, trustees, employees, and agents or assisting organizations against any and all claims for loss, damages, injuries, or other liabilities of any kind (including reasonable attorney's fees and/or costs of settlement) arising out of, resulting from or relating to our participation in the Noble Research Institute Junior Beef Excellence Program, which may include, but is not limited to, the testing referenced above, injury to the Steer (including death) and/or injuries or property damage caused by the Steer.

Whereas an affidavit is deemed by USDA's Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS) as a record of Country of Origin, we attest through firsthand knowledge¹, normal business records or subsequent producer affidavit that all livestock hereby provided to Tyson Fresh Meats, Inc. are of:

- U.S. Origin (exclusively born and raised in the U.S.)
- U.S., Canadian Origin
- U.S., Mexican Origin
- U.S., Canadian, Mexican Origin.

We attest that records reflecting specific transactions are available for inspection for the sole purpose of compliance with the country-of-origin labeling provisions contained in the Farm Security and Rural Investment Act of 2002, as amended.

We understand that if the origin of my livestock become other than that described above, we will notify the Noble Research Institute, in writing, when this occurs.

This Affidavit/Declaration of country-of-origin of livestock shall remain in effect until we revoke it, in writing, and such revocation is delivered to Tyson Fresh Meats, Inc. at 800 Stevens Port Drive Suite DD821B, Dakota Dunes, SD 57049.

We shall maintain records of livestock origin for one year from the date of delivery of the livestock to Tyson Fresh Meats.
