

# 10 TIME- SAVERS FOR PRODUCTIVE GRAZING

*Practical tips to help ranchers

## 01 CREATE A FLEXIBLE GRAZING PLAN

A grazing plan gives you a roadmap for the season. Build flexibility into the plan so you can adapt to fluctuations in weather or forage growth without stress.

## 02 PRE-SET GRAZING PADDOCKS

Divide your pastures into smaller paddocks ahead of time using temporary fencing. This allows for quick, stress-free livestock moves and ensures better forage utilization without extra effort later.

## 03 AUTOMATE WATER TROUGH MONITORING

Smart sensors can notify you when water levels are low, saving trips to check remote tanks.

## 04 USE TEMPORARY FENCING FOR QUICK ADJUSTMENTS

Portable electric fencing allows you to customize grazing strategies by easily adjusting paddock sizes. This flexibility helps you control grazing pressure, experiment with different setups, and quickly see the positive impacts on your land — all without the hassle of permanent infrastructure.

## 05 ROTATE WATER SOURCES STRATEGICALLY

Set up multiple water access points to improve livestock distribution and reduce time spent moving animals. These don't have to be permanent troughs — invest in a few portable options with reliable access to clean water, such as risers and quick-connect systems, for added flexibility.

## 06 STANDARDIZE YOUR RECORD- KEEPING

Use simple tools — like a notebook or ranch management app — to track forage growth, livestock health and grazing patterns. Consistent recordkeeping saves time when it's decision-making time.

## 07 SET UP SHADE AND SHELTER ROTATION

Portable shade structures can move with livestock, improving their comfort and saving time spent addressing heat stress.

## 08 TRAIN LIVESTOCK TO FOLLOW FEED OR A CALL

With more active management and frequent moves in adaptive grazing, livestock will naturally learn your routine. You can also train them to respond to feed or a call, making gathering and sorting more efficient.

## 09 BATCH YOUR CHORES

Group similar tasks — like fence repair or forage scouting — into one session instead of spreading them out over the week. This saves trips and minimizes interruptions.

## 10 LEAN ON YOUR GRAZING NETWORK

Connect with other ranchers to share strategies, troubleshoot challenges and learn shortcuts. Collaborative problem-solving can often save you hours of trial and error.
